1. Review of performance (Cont'd)

Current Quarter vs. Previous Year Corresponding Quarter

The Group's revenue grew by 15% to RM119.12 million, mainly due to higher average selling prices of CPO and PK. Profit before tax (PBT) increased substantially to RM16.72 million, marking a 150% year-over-year (YoY) rise. This was primarily attributed to better margins in the plantation, oil mill, and power plant segments.

Performance by business segment for the quarter, compared to the corresponding period last year, is presented below:

- (i) Plantation Profit increased significantly by 88%, from RM6.25 million to RM11.78 million, underpinned by a 25% rise in the average FFB selling price with a marginal increase in FFB yields of 1%.
- (ii) Oil Mill Profit rose sharply by 380%, from RM0.49 million to RM2.35 million, largely due to stronger contribution from downstream activities.
- (iii) Power Plant Profit increased by 239%, from RM0.83 million to RM2.81 million, supported by improved plant efficiency and stronger contributions from non-power-generating activities. The construction of the new boiler and turbine remains on track for completion in Q3 FY25 and is expected to deliver additional operational performance. Plans for the refurbishment of the existing biomass boiler and turbine are also underway.

The Group recorded a PBT of RM16.72 million, representing a 24% decrease quarter over quarter. The drop in PBT was mainly due to a 29% drop in FFB yields.

3. Commentary on prospects

The Group anticipates that CPO prices may soften in the near term due to geopolitical uncertainties, recently imposed U.S. tariffs and expectations of a seasonal rebound in FFB yields.

Going forward, the Group anticipates that rising production costs and labor shortages will continue to pose challenges for the industry.

To stay competitive, the Group will focus on:

- 1) Implementing additional cost-saving initiatives across all segments.
- 2) Enhancing FFB yields through consistent process improvements, replanting activities and mechanisation.
- 3) Identifying synergistic opportunities to diversify earnings.

These strategies are expected to position the Group to sustain satisfactory profitability levels throughout the 2025 financial year.
